High Peak Residents Deserve The Best Care Too!

A legal challenge might overturn the Healthier Together decision

Healthier Together has named Stockport's Stepping Hill hospital as the fourth specialist centre for emergency abdominal surgery.

Around 30,000 High Peak residents rely on Stepping Hill hospital for their medical care.

However, Keep Wythenshawe Special, an organisation set up by five doctors at Wythenshawe Hospital, is challenging the decision and has won the right to have a court hearing (Judicial Review). They want to overturn the decision so Wythenshawe is named as the specialist centre for abdominal surgery and NOT Stepping Hill.

If Stepping Hill is not selected, more than 17,000 High Peak residents will not be able to reach a specialist hospital for abdominal surgery within the 45 minute emergency travel time.
