Homework

For homework this half term, we would like the children to complete a project based on our History topic of Anglo Saxons and Vikings. Reading at home

We are encouraging the children to read every night at home and ask that you please sign their diaries to let us know that they have read and how they are getting on. It is essential that your child is reading at home every night and that their diary has been signed by an adult.

Spellings

Your child's spellings will be put on Spelling Shed on a weekly basis. It is essential that the children complete at least 5 games on Spelling Shed each night throughout the week. They will be tested on a Thursday.

Times Tables

I have set the children a challenge each week on TT Rockstars to complete at least 25 minutes practicing their times tables. The times tables that are set change on a Sunday but the challenge starts on a Friday. The children will be taking times tables tests each week this half term on a Thursday.
