EYFS and KS1 have the option of one lap (2.5k) though many choose to do a second lap. KS2 children relish the chance to do 2 laps, the full 5k.

Entry to the race costs ± 3 or you can collect a sponsor form from the office. We normally raise about ± 800 for Cancer Research and the last time we got over ± 1000 for this fantastic charity.

We are so happy with our new Outdoor Classroom and most classes have had a visit to it. This building wouldn't have been possible without the generous donations when we had the Foret School fire, a substantial donation in memory of Mr Platt, the school's first headteacher from his family and the money from the work Mrs Walker does for the Diocese.
