RELIGIOUS EDUCATION	The Chosen People; Bible Stories; Abraham, Moses, Daniel and The Lion's Den. Focus objective;  - Understanding that we have been chosen be God  - Putting our Trust in God like Gods Chosen people.  - Ability to re-tell stories about Gods chosen people.  - Talk about feelings of God's chosen people.  Mysteries (Christmas) Focus; The Trinity, The Nativity - Talk, wonder and ask questions about some mysteries. Recognise that some questions are hard to answer - Describe the mystery of God as Trinity, using religion words - Retell Nativity story, talk about characters and discufeelings of characters.	The Good News Bible Stories; Jairus Daughter, Jesus heals the Leper, Feeding of 5000. Focus Objectives;  - Ask and answer questions about the feelings and experiences of characters in the stories  - Know that Jesus can turn sadness into joy.  - Give clear, simple descriptions of what these stories tell us about God  - Know that they should always remember to thank Jesus for his help  - Answer questions like, 'Is it important to say thank you?' 'Why?'  - Know that Jesus used his power to help others. Reflect on the importance of these events.  - Know that Jesus brought the good news of God's love. Reflect on what this means for us.  The Mass  - Know that the celebration of Mass is important.  - Know about the readings at Mass and why we should listen to them.  - Know and appreciate that at the Consecration the bread and wine are changed into Jesus.	Eastertide  - Know that Jesus rose from the dead and still lives with us.  - Know that Jesus told the disciples that he would send the Holy Spirit after he had gone back to Heaven. The Holy Spirit helped the disciples and helps us.  - Know that Jesus returned to Heaven and promised to return again and this gives us hope.  - Know the story of Pentecost. Know that the Holy Spirit is promised to us.  The Church is Born  - Know that when the apostles received the Holy Spirit they spread the good news. Know that we too can spread the good news  - Know about the early Christian community.  Understand that we are part of it today.  - Know that the apostles realised that God could work through them.  - Know the story of Peter's escape from prison — reflect on its meaning.
