- A Kingdom is ruled by a King or a Queen

- In the Bible, Jesus uses parables (stories with meanings) in which to explain things.
- Jesus compares God's Kingdom to a mustard seed, a treasure or a pearl.

- In confirmation

- Power over nature
- Power over disease
- Power over death
