LENTEN RETREAT DAYS

We had a lovely, final week of term. On Monday and Tuesday, our Houses came together to focus on a different day of Holy Week and prepare a station as part of our prayer trail. As part of the prayer trail, each House visited church for Stations of the Cross. On Thursday, we came together again for a beautiful Lenten Service. MAY CROWNING

This Friday 2nd May at 9:15am, we are bringing back an old tradition in the church that I am sure many of you will fondly remember from your own childhood. As it is the month of May, we will show our devotion to Mary in a special way, with flowers. Traditionally, those who are participating in the Sacramental Programme have the honour of crowning Our Lady. We are also asking every child to bring in a single flower (ideally white) and they will form a procession into church and place their flower in front of the statue of Our Lady. Please do not worry, if you can't provide a flower, as we will have plenty of spares! A whole school Mass will then follow the May Crowning, with some of our Nursery children and Mini Vinnies taking a lead with the readings and prayers.

THURSDAY is **Community Assembly**. All are welcome to attend in the School Hall at 9am. We celebrate all the good work that has gone on during the week. We appreciate your patience after dropping your children off as it takes us a few minutes to convert the hall from Breakfast Club to Assembly Hall!

BREAKFAST CLUB

Our Breakfast Club is available every morning in the School Hall (using the side door). This needs to be booked in advance using the app. There are two sessions to book onto. The first session from

7:30am until 8:45am costing £2.50 per child. The second session begins at 8:15am and costs £1. Children must arrive no later than 8.30am.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

We continue to have excellent attendance at our after- school clubs. Children are really enjoying playing with their friends, learning new skills and making crafts to take home. All children from Nursery - Year 6 can attend our after-school clubs. We have at least four after school activities each day including: Lego club, crafts, crochet, fun with food, volleyball, cheerleading, games and even Yoga!

These sessions need to be booked in advance, at least the day before, using the app. All activities $cost \pm 1$ per day. On the app you will have four options (for each of the activities on offer). The fifth option is for extended wraparound after 4:30pm. Many of our clubs are now at full capacity so please book early to avoid disappointment.

WRAPAROUND CARE

Wraparound care is from 4:30pm-6pm. This costs £6 per session (which includes the £1 for after school club). Children will receive a choice of snacks and drinks each day e.g. wraps, sandwiches, bagels, crumpets, pizza, fruit and salad.

TOP-UP PAYMENTS

In an emergency (e.g. an urgent appointment), you can book onto breakfast, after-school or wraparound clubs on the actual day. Simply pay the correct top-up on the app and inform the office.

PE KIT

Next half term it is multi-skills/games for the infants and athletics for the Juniors.

PE is on a Tuesday for Nursery children and Years 2-5. PE is on Friday for Nursery (they have two shorter sessions), Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. For the summer term, Year 3 have an extra PE session on a Friday too.

On PE day children come to school in their PE Kits. Please can you ensure that it is our school kit of plain white t-shirt and plain dark blue or black shorts/jogging bottoms, along with their school jumper.

NEW UNIFORM

Alternatively, you can buy any suitable uniform (without a badge) from supermarkets. Please make sure all clothes are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

FOREST SCHOOL

This half term it is Year 4's turn for Forest School on Mondays and Reception on Thursdays. Children need to arrive at school already dressed in their forest school clothes and bring their wellies or outdoor footwear with them in a bag.

NURSERY

We still have some places in our Nursery if you know of anyone with a child who is already 3 or will turn 3 this academic year. If they are, give us a ring, we may be able to offer them places. Remember, we now offer up to 30-hour places in our Nursery.
