We thank them all for their years of service to our school community.

As a result of staff leaving, we have to had to make a couple of changes to our existing staffing structure. Mrs Kinder, will now be teaching Nursery on a Thursday and Friday morning. Miss Bostock (our Deputy Headteacher) will be teaching Nursery every Thursday and Friday afternoon. Mrs Townsend, will continue to teach in Year 1 during the afternoons, so there will be no impact whatsoever on Year 1. As Mrs Kinder (one of our two SEND co-ordinators) now has a greater teaching commitment, we have asked Miss Chapman (our other SEND co-ordinator) to temporarily take on this role full time. We also welcome Miss Rogers to the team. She will be one of our Midday Assistants, mainly supporting our Nursery children during lunchtime. On Monday, we have a new cook, Ms Lewis, joining the kitchen team. I am sure she will be a great asset in continuing to provide an excellent dinner service for our children.

EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Great news, our overall attendance figure is on the way up. Last week, we reached 95%. Our school attendance target is 96% (so not too far off!). Let's keep up this momentum and continue to encourage excellent attendance. As you know, time away from school has a negative impact on pupils' progress and attainment. Please try to make appointments outside of the school day and do remember that holidays during term time cannot be authorised and may lead to a penalty fine. If you would like some support or guidance with attendance matters, please do contact us in school.

A new incentive for encouraging excellent attendance is our golden ticket award for the class who achieve the best attendance figure. This will be announced each week at our Community Assembly. Most classes have now won a golden ticket and prizes have included: Just Dance Party, extra Golden Time, a movie afternoon and an art party. The elusive own clothes day ticket is still there to be won!

All children with 96% or above attendance at the end of this Autumn Term will receive a certificate and will be entered into a prize draw. 1st Prize worth £100, 2nd Prize (worth £30) and 3rd Prize (worth £20). Previous prizes have included gift vouchers for Go Ape, Play Factore, Active Tameside, Hollywood Bowl and Cineworld.

CHRISTMAS DINNER DAY

FOREST SCHOOL

This half term, it is Year 5 turn for Forest School now on a Wednesday and Year 3 on a Thursday. Children need to arrive at school already dressed in their forest school clothes and

bring their wellies or outdoor footwear with them in a bag. Nursery have Forest School all year round (weather permitting) every Wednesday.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

We continue to have excellent attendance at our after-school clubs. Children are really enjoying playing with their friends, learning new skills and making crafts to take home. All children from Nursery - Year 6 can attend our after-school clubs. We have at least four after school activities each day and usually a least of choice of two clubs for each age group. These sessions need to be booked in advance, at least the day before, using the app. All activities cost £1 per day. On the app you will have four options (for each of the activities on offer). The fifth option is for extended wraparound after 4:30pm. Many of our clubs are now at full capacity so please book early to avoid disappointment.
